SELECTABLE WORKSHOPS

You can choose 2 workshops during registration

WORKSHOP 1 **Nicola Pangia** – Communication in Online Teaching

Discussion about the need to continue and reiterate routines, consolidate learning, “feed” skills and maintain, as much as possible, a didactic continuity with children. Communication times and methods are remodulated, new ideas of interaction and motivation through the screen both in a synchronous and asynchronous way are found.

WORKSHOP 2 **Vincenzo Sparacio** – Every Word is Rhythm

A path based on the use of language to discover the various rhythms existing within it. Through nursery rhymes, grammalet, nonsense, it is possible to build didactic paths that can lead to the creation of pieces of ensemble music, first with the voice, then with the body and movement, finally also with instruments.

WORKSHOP 3 **Umut Serkan Özkan** – Sounds of the Street Vendors

Music is used as a communication tool by human beings as well as in nature. One of the most beautiful examples is street vendors, marketers, sellers. They call their customers with different melodies, almost creating their own brands with their voices. In this workshop, we will experience the most practical form of elemental music, starting with the street vendors of Istanbul 100 years ago.

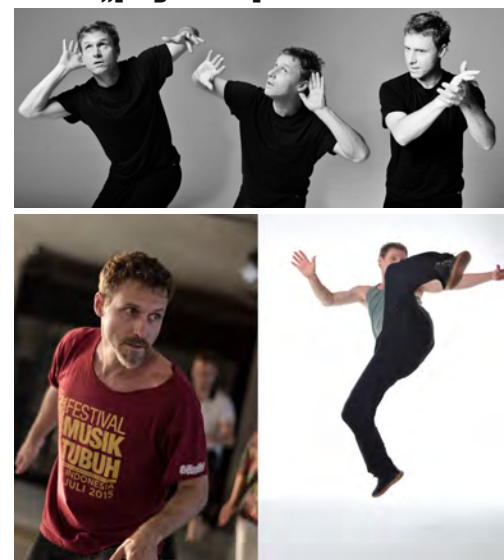
WORKSHOP 4 **Senem Özyoğurtcu** – Orff-Schulwerk with Turkish Music

With the studies of Carl Orff and Gunild Keetman the intercultural perspective was revealed and the aesthetic and creative possibilities of different cultures were included in the course processes. In this workshop, you will be able to find out how our maqams (modes), syncopated rhythms, and folk dances will meet with Orff-Schulwerk.

WORKSHOP 5 **Charles Raszl** – Fragment, Mosaic, Mandala

Through Singing, Dance and Body Music, we'll explore the path of rhythmic cells (Fragment) in a dialogue with rhythmic melodies (Mosaic), up to a circular system that dances (Mandala). This path takes inspiration from Brazilian history and culture. The aesthetic scenery and the technical resources come from traditional Brazilian dances & songs, and from the body percussion of the Barbatuques group.
